



The Actun Tunichil Muknal (ATM Cave)

Experience Overview

Participants will embark on an unforgettable exploration of the ATM Cave, where Belize's pristine nature, Maya history, and raw adventure come together. This experience begins with a guided trek through the Tapir Mountain Nature Reserve, a lush habitat rich with wildlife and towering forest canopy. The approach includes three river crossings of varying depth—ranging from knee-deep wading to refreshing swims.

Upon reaching the cave entrance, the real adventure begins. Participants will swim into the limestone passageway and continue through crystal-clear streams, winding corridors, and ancient stone chambers. Expert guides lead small groups through this protected environment, highlighting its significance and ensuring the highest safety standards are upheld at all times.

Inside the cave, the journey becomes deeply immersive. Participants will encounter remarkable geological formations, carefully preserved Maya pottery, ceremonial altars, and human skeletal remains. The most iconic is the "Crystal Maiden," a calcified skeleton whose glittering surface—created by thousands of years of mineral deposits—offers a humbling and awe-inspiring reminder of ancient rituals once performed deep within the cave.

What to Expect

- A guided rainforest hike with river crossings
- Swimming into the cave entrance
- Wading and climbing through natural limestone formations
- Tight passageways, rocky ledges, and water levels from shallow to chest-high
- A complete immersion into a protected underground world
- Life jackets provided and required throughout the tour

This tour is designed for travelers seeking an authentic, hands-on archaeological adventure. It is physically active but led with care, ensuring participants move at a safe, steady pace.

Important Information

Intensity Level: Moderate to challenging

Minimum Height: 40 inches

Restrictions:

- Not suitable for individuals with heart problems, serious medical conditions, or recent surgeries
- Not recommended for pregnant women or travelers with chronic back issues
- Not accessible for participants with walking disabilities or mobility challenges
- Cameras and electronic devices are strictly prohibited by the Government of Belize

What to Wear

The cave environment is naturally cool, and many guests find the temperature refreshing but noticeably cold during the swims and extended time in the water. Wearing the right clothing significantly enhances comfort.

Recommended attire:

- Swimwear layered with lightweight but durable shorts
- Long-sleeve rash guards (help retain warmth in the cool cave water)
- Closed-toe hiking shoes or trainers that can get wet (high-traction soles are essential)
- Optional: Neoprene socks for added warmth

Important note:

Participants must wear socks inside the dry chamber areas to help preserve delicate cultural zones.

What to Bring

- Extra dry clothes and footwear for after the tour
- Towel
- Socks (mandatory)
- At least 1 liter of water in a reusable bottle (managed by the guide)
- Insect repellent
- Light snacks (kept in the vehicle)
- Small backpack to remain with personal items in the tour vehicle



Tips for Participants

Past travelers describe this as “challenging but entirely achievable for anyone in decent shape.” Proper attire—especially rash guards, board shorts, and sturdy closed-toe footwear—greatly enhances comfort while navigating cool water temperatures, slippery surfaces, and uneven terrain.

The atmosphere inside the cave is not meant to be frightening. Guides are highly experienced, trained in wilderness operations, and skilled at pacing the tour to suit participant comfort levels. Most guests find the blend of water, climbing, and exploration energizing rather than strenuous.

Kids & Family Information

This tour can be suitable for adventurous children who meet the 40-inch minimum height requirement and are comfortable with swimming, hiking, and being in enclosed spaces.

Families who have completed the ATM Cave often describe the experience as:

- A real-life adventure that inspires confidence and curiosity
- Educational, engaging, and unforgettable
- A bonding experience as children feel capable, brave, and proud

However, parents should keep in mind:

- The tour begins with a swim
- The environment is naturally dark and enclosed in some areas
- The experience lasts several hours inside the cave
- Children must be able to follow guide instructions closely
